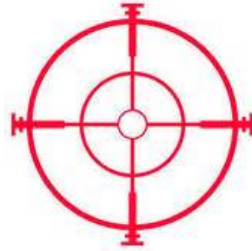

High Power Rifle Matches

What do I need to start shooting high power rifle competition at CSC? Hearing and Eye protection along with some money for ammo and match fees. THAT'S IT!!!

- This runs \$36 to \$41 for a 60 round draw of 223 with the match fee.
- CSC has National Match AR-15's and Service Grade M1 Garands available for borrowing at the match
- 223, 30-06, and 308 available for purchase at very competitive prices at the matches.

When are the matches, and what do the other competitors bring for equipment?

- The matches are usually held on the 3rd Saturday of the month with the first relay starting at 8:30 AM March through October. The next Match in 2015 is April 25. Watch the CSC Calendar for dates and times.
- What other equipment (besides hearing and eye protection) do others bring?
 - Spotting Scope
 - Shooting mat – club has these available
 - Stapler
 - Shooting jacket – really all you need is something to protect your elbows in the prone position. A sweatshirt works fine.
 - Your own rifle and ammo. The usual guns are AR-15, M1 Garand, or M1A. The gun is required to have open sights (no optics allowed)
 - Rifle Sling

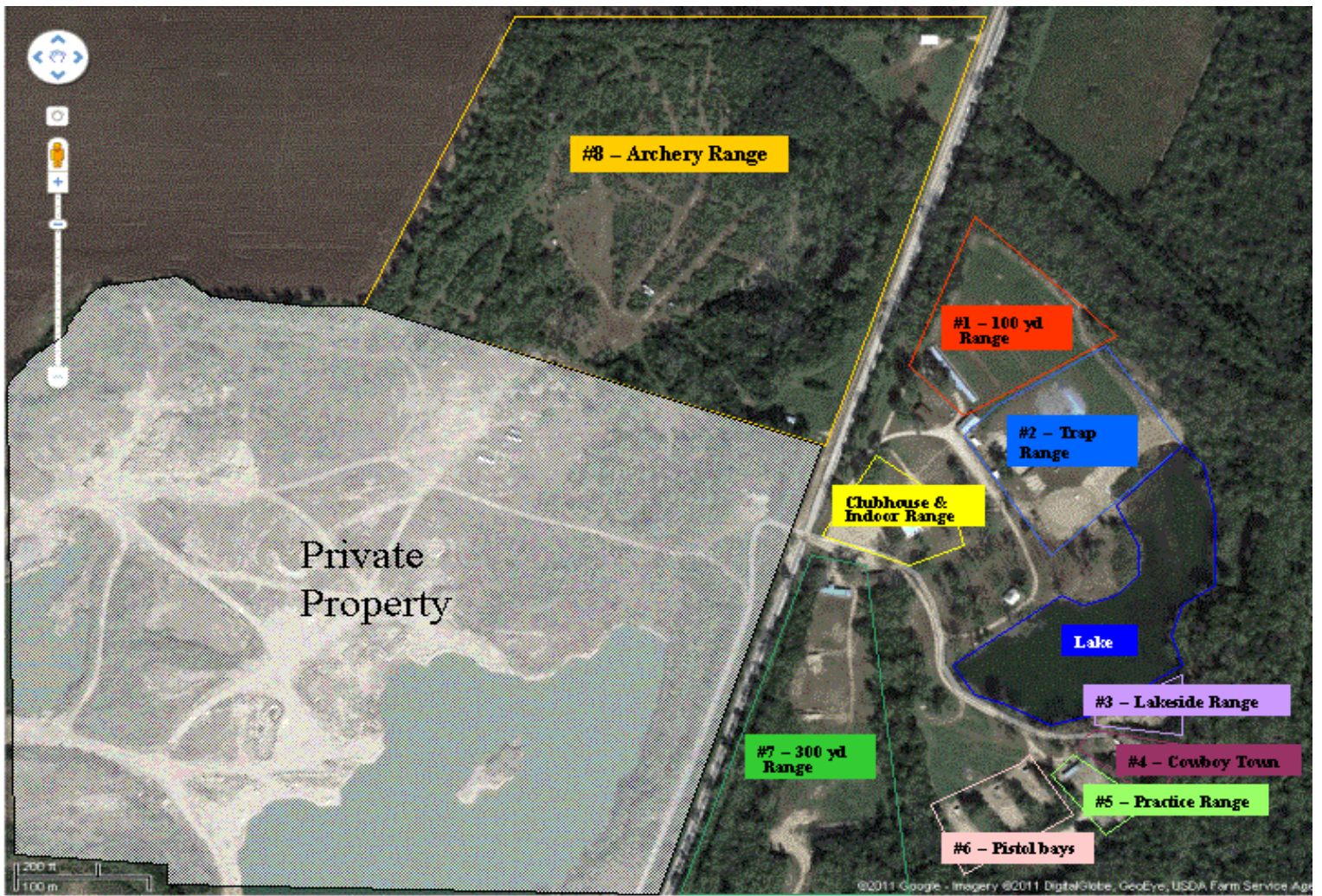
This is a herd of turtles in our lake. Enjoy the wildlife on our grounds.
