## NOTICES & INFORMATION

**Lost Binoculars:** To Cal with the white beard, driving a white truck, who was shooting the 30 Bellum, Sunday, 8/6/2017, on Range #10, I have your binoculars that you left on the shooting bench. Please call Loy Cletcher @ 309/370-5592, to make arrangements to get them returned.

**Lost & Found:** The Club has accumulated a number of shirts, jackets, equipment keys, car keys, glasses, etc. You have until the gun show to claim these items. After the show everything left will be disposed of.

**NRA Gun Safety Rules:** Remember & Practice them every time you handle any firearm. You should know the most of them by heart. They are:

- 1) Always keep the gun pointed in a safe direction.
- 2) Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
- 3) Always keep the gun unloaded until ready to use.
- 4) Know your target and what is beyond.
- 5) Know how to use the gun safely.
- 6) Be sure the gun is safe to operate.
- 7) Use only the correct ammunition for your gun.
- 8) Wear eye and ear protection as appropriate.
- 9) Never use alcohol or drugs (including prescription) before or while shooting.
- 10) Store guns so that they are not accessible to unauthorized persons.

**Improper Targets & Target Placement:** It has been repeatedly stated in past issues of this newsletter that certain types of items are not proper targets as well as issues of improper target placement. This information is also reflected in the Club By-Laws and Range Rules. What is wrong with this picture??



You should have found 3 improper target placements. They all involve paper plates. One is stapled to the support pole and the other two are stapled to close to the support pole.

### 2017 WORK HOURS

### **INTRODUCTION TO BULLS-EYE PISTOL SHOOTING**

Class starts Wednesday @ 6:00 PM Chillicothe Sportsman Club. The class runs for 4 weeks, every Wednesday night. Class covers

- Safety
- Operation of pistols
- Techniques for sighting
- Breathing
- Trigger control
- Rules of Bulls-eye shooting

No experience is necessary; we can provide Ruger Mark III 22/45 pistols to use ammo and targets or you can bring your own pistol (no Magnum rounds, i.e. 357mag, 44mag). 22lr, 380acp, 9mm, 38spl, 40S&W, 45 ACP, etc. are OK.

Cost is \$70.00 this covers use of club pistol and .22 ammo (350 rounds) and targets

Cost is \$35.00 if you are supplying your own gun and ammo (targets provided)

Class dates are October 4<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>, & 25<sup>th</sup>.

The class is limited to 12 people. We usually have 1 instructor to every 3 to 4 participants to guide you through the class.
