NOTICES & INFORMATION

Lost & Found: The Club has accumulated a number of shirts, jackets, equipment keys, car keys, glasses, etc. You have until the gun show to claim these items. After the show everything left will be disposed of.

NRA Gun Safety Rules: Remember & Practice them every time you handle any firearm. You should know most of them by heart. They are:

- 1) Always keep the gun pointed in a safe direction.
- 2) Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
- 3) Always keep the gun unloaded until ready to use.
- 4) Know your target and what is beyond.
- 5) Know how to use the gun safely.
- 6) Be sure the gun is safe to operate.
- 7) Use only the correct ammunition for your gun.
- 8) Wear eye and ear protection as appropriate.
- 9) Never use alcohol or drugs (including prescription) before or while shooting.
- 10) Store guns so that they are not accessible to unauthorized persons.

Officers serve a one year term and directors serve two year terms.

2018 Dues & Fees: You may renew your membership for 2018 at the Annual Meeting. The various fees are:

- Annual Membership - \$100.00
- Work Hours (10 hours per Annual, Associate Life, and Life Member under 65) - \$15.00 for every hour not worked
- Life Member over 65: - no work hour requirement
- Land Fund - \$25.00 per member

Your 2018 fee will range from a minimum of \$25.00 to a maximum of \$275.00, depending upon your personal membership status.

2017 WORK HOURS

Remember Work Hour fees have been increased to \$15.00, for every work hour not worked in 2017, when you have to pay your membership renewal fees for 2018. This could cost you up to \$150.00 for hours not worked. Work Hour Credits can be earned for assisting with many of the Club's various events (check with the various event directors' to find out where assistance is needed) or participating in any of the scheduled monthly work parties. YOU ONLY HAVE 3 MORE MONTHS TO GET YOUR 2017 WORK HOUR CREDITS.

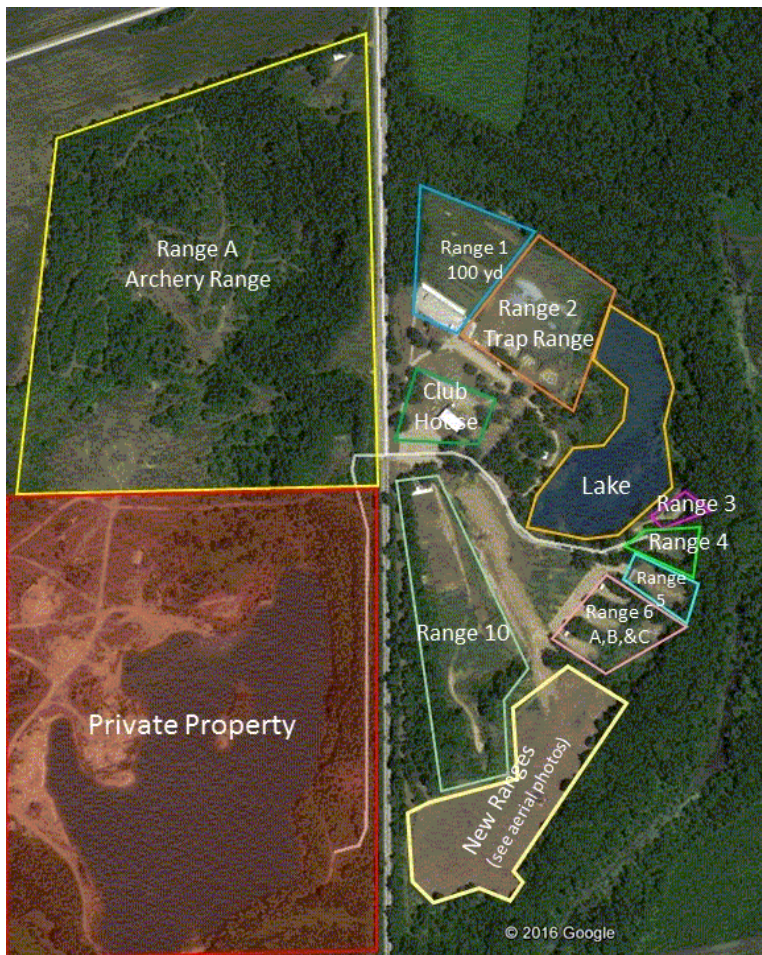
