NOTICES & INFORMATION

Annual Meeting & Elections: The Annual Meeting will take place on Tuesday, November 14, 6:30 pm in the Clubhouse. All officer positions are up for election/re-election and 4 director positions are up for election/re-election. Officers serve a one year term and directors serve two year terms.

2018 Dues & Fees: You may renew your membership for 2018 at the Annual Meeting. The various fees are:

- Annual Membership - \$100.00
- Work Hours (10 hours per Annual, Associate Life, and Life Member under 65) - \$15.00 for every hour not worked
- Life Member over 65: - no work hour requirement
- Land Fund - \$25.00 per member

Your 2018 fee will range from a minimum of \$25.00 to a maximum of \$275.00, depending upon your personal membership status.

You may also pay your 2018 dues & fees at the Winter Gun Show if you did not renew at the Annual Meeting or via mail.

WINTER GUN SHOW

Remember the CSC Winter Gun Show is Saturday, December 2, 8:30 AM - 4 PM, and Sunday, December 3, 8:30 AM - 3 PM. There will be Vendors on both clubhouse levels.

Setup is Friday, 12/1, starting at 9:30 AM and cleanup is Sunday, 12/3, starting at 3 PM. Work hour credits will be given for both days.

If you want to bring any pies or cakes for work hour credits, you must contact Steve Risinger @ 309/208-1010, before you bring them out for the show. Most store bought pies & cakes will not be work hour credits qualified.

2017 WORK HOURS

Remember Work Hour fees have been increased to \$15.00, for every work hour not worked in 2017, when you have to pay your membership renewal fees for 2018. This could cost you up to \$150.00 for hours not worked. Work Hour Credits can be earned for assisting with many of the Club's various events (check with the various event directors' to find out where assistance is needed) or participating in any of the scheduled monthly work parties. YOU ONLY HAVE 2 MORE MONTHS TO GET YOUR 2017 WORK HOUR CREDITS.

RANGE SAFETY

THE CLUB IS STILL RECEIVING COMPLAINTS CONCERNING ERRANT ROUNDS LEAVING ONE RANGE AND AFFECTING SHOOTERS ON OTHER NEARBY RANGES.

- Please make sure that your target is positioned so that any low fired rounds impact the backstop and not the ground in front of the backstop.
- The same applies to high fired rounds. Make sure that any high fired rounds impact the backstop and don't escape the range by going over the top.

The side berms on all ranges should not to be used for target placement. They are not normally thick enough, **especially near the top**, to keep any fired rounds from escaping. Also do not use trees growing on the side berms as targets.



Again a reminder, Empty or Full cans & bottles are not proper targets. This rule also applies to many other items being used as targets that are not approved of in the Club Rules.

Alcohol/drugs do not mix with shooting. If you want to shoot, don't use them before going to the range or while at the range.

3 GUN MATCH RULES

For those of you not familiar with 3 gun, it is a very exciting shooting sport that requires a pistol, 9mm or larger, shotgun, 20 gauge or larger (typically a 12 gauge) and an Ar15. Some matches allow a pistol caliber carbine to be substituted for the Ar15. A belt is also needed with a pistol holster, pistol magazine holders and shotgun shell caddies.

You are placed in different divisions based on the type of firearms used. Open division allows optics on the pistol, shotgun and rifle. Tac-optics division allows a magnified optic on only the rifle. Tac-irons division allows only a non-magnified red dot, or iron sites, on the rifle. Some matches have different names for the same basic divisions. Bring out the firearms you have and we will put you in the proper division. You can contact Kip Jacobsen at contact info below with any questions.

Multiple stages are set up with a combination of a wide variety of paper, steel and clay targets requiring the use of one, two or all three of the firearms listed above. Score is based on time, with time added for missed targets.

Approximate minimum round count:

100 pistol

100 rifle

100 shotgun

4 slugs

No buckshot

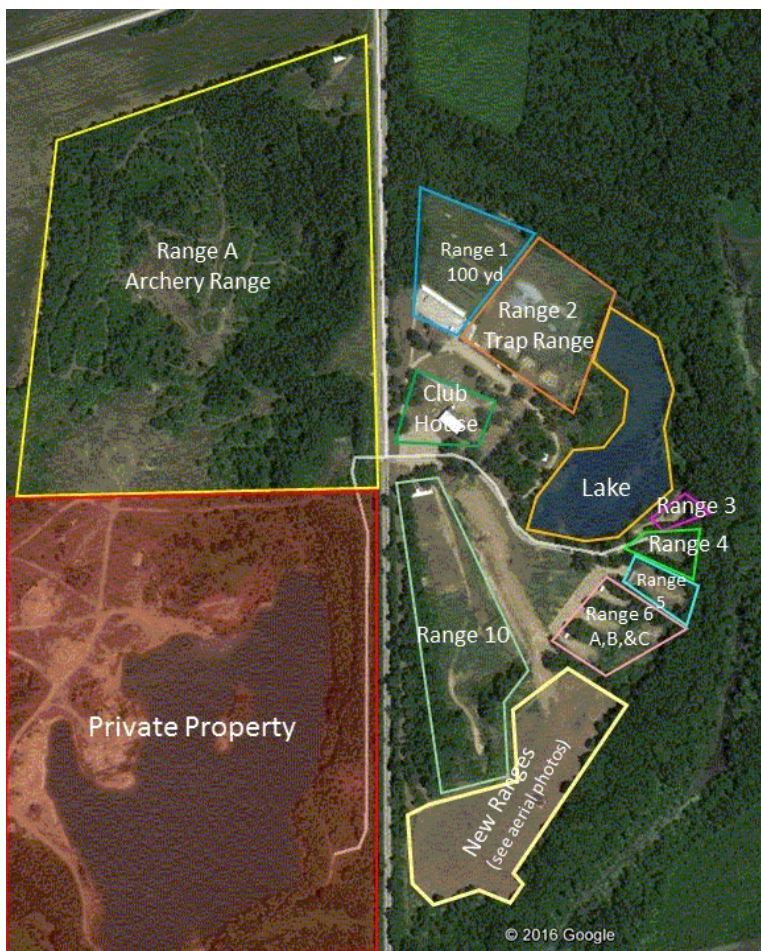
