## **NOTICES & INFORMATION**

**2018 Dues & Fees:** You may renew your membership for 2018 at the January 9 Meeting. The various fees are:

- Annual Membership - \$100.00
- Work Hours (10 hours per Annual, Associate Life, and Life Member under 65) - \$15.00 for every hour not worked
- Life Member over 65: - no work hour requirement
- Land Fund - \$25.00 per member

Your 2018 fee will range from a minimum of \$25.00 to a maximum of \$275.00, depending upon your personal membership status.

You may also pay your 2018 dues & fees by mailing your 2017 membership card and a check for the applicable amount owed to the club mailing address listed above and on your membership card.

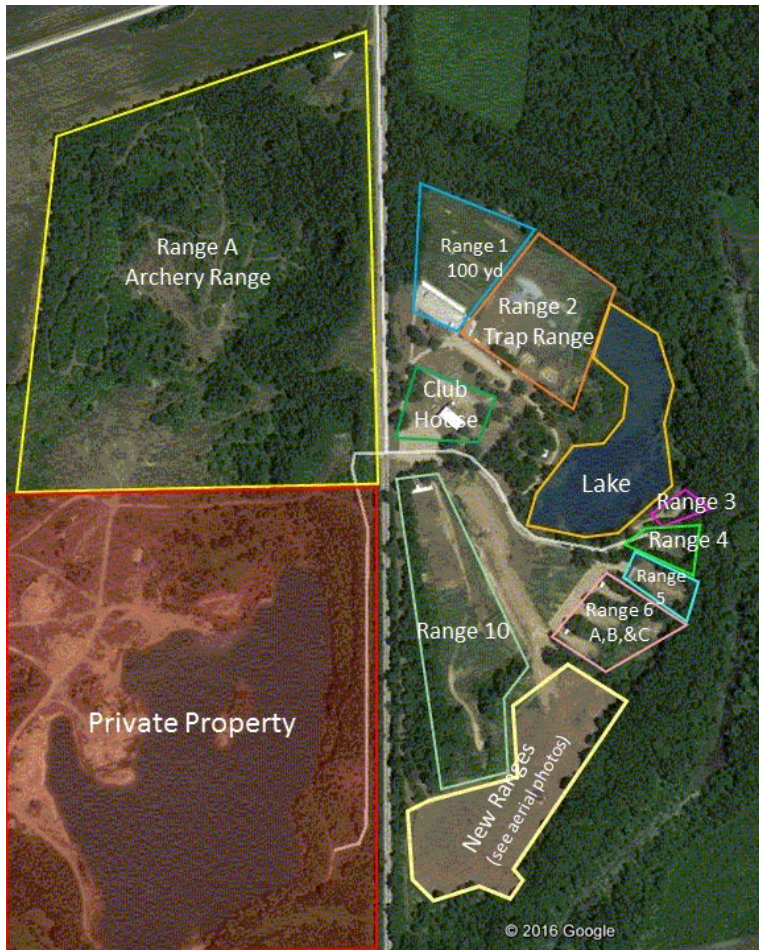
