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## **INFORMATION & NOTICES:**

**ARCHERY:** Moving forward on the Archery side of the club, WE are moving backwards!!!

The July shoot this year will be cancelled as we move into the next phase of the clubs archery program.

The August shoot will feature a 40 target course (possibly more) As well as seeing the old course hands setting up the course. If you haven't shot the course in a couple years, we invite you to come out and check it out. We have put together a team of shoot planners past and are looking to return the archery side of the club to its historical glory.

Archery, in the past, has been an ebb and flow discipline. On the boom years, it can support itself as well as a surplus of monies going into the coffers of the club. On boon years, it can be a money pit.

This is where the club membership can help out...

Tell your friends, get a crew together, and COME OUT and support. The course will be set up to challenge ALL disciplines. Compound (unlimited, as well as bow-hunter), traditional and even crossbows. Youth stakes will be set for the cubs, and keeping score is a matter of personal preference.

If you have never shot 3D archery, you are missing out!!! It doesn't take much, and it's good exercise. It is a GREAT family activity and August and September are key times to tighten up those bowhunting shots. (You know, so you don't have to make a whole year of excuses why you missed that deer of a lifetime AGAIN.) They usually don't stand at exactly 20 yards like your backyard target does.

**A REMINDER - NO BROADHEAD ARROWS ARE ALLOWED ON THE ARCHERY RANGE.**

**LEGISLATIVE ACTION INFORMATION:** Hello CSC Members, Gun owners across America - and especially in Illinois - must fight for our rights, or we will lose them. As I write this, there are 3 bills on Governor Rauner's desk that affect us; 3 bills that we need him to veto, despite enormous political pressure he faces to sign them into law. We need you involved!

Illinois: Ask Gov. Rauner to Veto the Gun Control Bills

- Senate Bill 337, which will create a firearm registry & shut down gun stores.
- Senate Bill 3256 will expand the 72 hour waiting period to all firearms.
- House Bill 2354 allows 2A rights to be revoked without due process. (This bill could allow an anonymous caller who merely claims they are 'concerned' you may be a threat, to trigger police seizing your firearms, and leaving you the hassle & expense, of proving you aren't a threat... This madness is ripe for anyone to harass gun owners: ex-spouses, spurned lovers, annoyed neighbors, rebellious teens, gun-haters, anyone upset over pro-gun signs, spiteful co-workers/bosses/employees, etc...

**Don't think it can't happen here - this insanity has already passed the Illinois House of Representatives...**

Please contact Gov. Rauner TODAY and urge him to VETO SB 337, SB 3256, and HB 2354 - do it today!

**ATTENTION - ALL CLUB MEMBERS:** Your club has been the repeated recipient of the destruction of club property. Examples are:

**ISSUES SEEN / NOTED:**

- Placing targets too close to the ground can result in ricochets.
- Attaching targets to the exterior frames of club provided target boards and not inside of the frames.
- Using club target boards for patterning shotguns. The club provided target frames are 48 "wide. (Please bring your own target board & frame to use for patterning your shotgun).

- Bringing & shooting at improper targets (fire extinguishers, small safes, propane bottles, etc.).

### **DESTRUCTION OF CLUB PROPERTY:**

- Using club provided empty brass buckets as targets.
- Using club target boards for patterning shotguns. (see above)

### **CONSEQUENCES:**

- When caught you will be brought before the Board to explain why you felt justified in violating Club Rules.
- Penalties imposed by the Board could be a minimum of 30 to 90 day suspension of club usage to the loss of your CSC Club membership.
- **Are these penalty possibilities worth breaking Club Rules?**

### **CSC CLUB RULES:**

- All of the above listed problems are addressed in the Club Rules.
- Each member has received a copy of the Club Rules. The Club Rules are also posted on the CSC Website.
- Each Range has its own Specific Rules posted.
