2021 Membership Renewal Process

We typically start our membership renewals at the annual meeting in November. That part will not change this year, but due to COVID-19, the process will be different this year. To maintain social distancing and make the process safe for our members, voting will be handled differently as well. Gathering ballots and getting them counted will likely take much longer. Renewing your membership the traditional way would also take considerably longer, so to keep the annual meeting from dragging on till a late hour, we have decided to make some changes to the process for this year.

We will collect membership renewals at the meeting; however, we will not be handing out cards and keys. Instead we will mail them to you as soon as possible after the meeting. We will have peel-and-seal envelopes available for you to put your membership card and payment into at a table and another box to deposit your renewal into. Please pay by check. If you insist on paying in cash, you will be responsible for having the correct change. We will not be making change at the meeting.

You can also return your key in the same envelop if you wish to, but don't forget that you will still need it if you want to come out to the club before January 1.
