Ryan Block finished 3^{rd} in conf. and 19^{th} in state, while AJ Hammer finished tied 4^{th} in conf. and 21^{st} in state. Both were awarded "All State" at the

state tournament of which 13 team members participated in. Other notable students were Max Gregory who was 16th in conf. and Beau Sarver 25th, while Caitlyn Gillette was 18th among female students. All of our student athletes are improving their skills and most importantly are being safe and having fun. The team typically shoots every Sunday evening during the Spring and Fall semesters and has make-up nights on either Monday or Wednesday, so come on out and watch our youth in action or better yet help support
