IVC trap participants must either complete the Hunter Ed course (Free of charge) or the IHSA SAFE on-line program before participating on the trap team.

If you're thinking of hunting out of state, please check the requirements for the state you are considering, as many western states have earlier dates than IL, such as CO's date of Jan. 1, 1949.

Membership Renewal Time Is Here

Our annual membership renewal period is nearing a close for 2023. You will need to submit your renewal through the mail at this point. If you haven't renewed at this time, then please mail your membership card with any work hours signed off and a check for what you owe to:

Do not mail in your key. First, you may want to use it. It is still good until January 1. Second, it may damage mail sorting equipment if you don't use the proper envelops (and the Post Office may charge for the repairs).

Don't forget that all memberships expired on <u>December 31</u>, and the locks were changed early morning on January 1. You have until February 1, 2023 to renew your membership.

If annual members have not renewed by February 1, 2023, you will have to apply again and start over as a new member. You will still owe for work hours not completed in 2022.

How much do you owe?

Annual members will owe \$100 for dues, plus \$25 for the land fund and \$15/hour for each of the required 10 work hours you have not completed. Sorry, no extra credit for work hours beyond the 10 required. Associate Life members of any age and Life members under the age of 65 will owe \$25 for the land fund and \$15/hour for each of the required 10 work hours you have not completed. Life members age 65 and over owe \$25 for the land fund. We accept cash, personal checks, bank checks or money orders. We do not accept credit or debit cards, bit coin or any forms of electronic payment. Checks are recommended if you are mailing in your payment. Mailing cash is at the member's risk, we are not responsible if it is lost in the mail.

I would appreciate it if they would not staple payment and card together. The first thing I have to do is separate them and this just adds time to the process and is annoying.
