Happy Holidays!

We encourage you to get out and enjoy our Club.

We focus very heavily on safety at our Club. For a full listing of all our rules, please find them on our website.

Just a reminder under Part A of the <u>General Rules for All Ranges:</u> "Range safety is of utmost importance: No handling of firearms when anyone is down range. All guns will be cleared, unloaded, and benched (or in the racks) before anyone goes down range. Keep guns pointed down range or in a safe direction at all times, and make sure that all guns are unloaded before proceeding to put up targets. Leave the actions open for easy inspection by other shooters. **Use only safe targets and direct all shooting towards the backstops**." The last sentence, in bold type, is what needs to be emphasized. When shooting pistols on the 100-yard range (Range 1) at the 25-yard line, be sure the targets are place high enough to ensure the bullets strike the berm.

Membership Renewal Time Is Here! Our annual membership renewal period started in November for 2025. You can renew in person at the December or January board meetings (second Tuesday of the month). Don't forget that all memberships expire on December 31 and the lock will be changed to the 2025 keyed lock on January 1, 2025. You have until February 1, 2025 to renew your membership. If annual members have not renewed by February 1, 2025, you will have to apply again and start over as a new member. You will still owe for work hours not completed in 2024. Second, it may damage mail sorting equipment if you don't use the proper envelops (and the Post Office may charge for the repairs.

How much do you owe: Annual members will owe \$100 for dues, plus \$25 for the land fund and \$15/hour for each of the required 10 work hours you have not completed. If no work hours were completed, you will need to send \$275 to cover your dues. Sorry, no extra credit for work hours beyond the 10 required. Associate Life members of any age and Life members under the age of 65 will owe \$25 for the land fund and \$15/hour for each of the required 10 work hours you have not completed. Life members age 65 and over owe \$25 for the land fund.

We accept cash, personal checks, bank checks or money orders. We do not accept credit or debit cards, bit coin or any forms of electronic payment. Checks are recommended if you are mailing in your payment. Mailing cash is at the member's risk, we are not responsible if it is lost in the mail.

It would be appreciated if you would not staple payment and card together. The first thing that has to be done is separate them and this just adds time to the process and is annoying.


