2025 YSSI - CANCELLED:

The Youth Shooting Sports Invitational (YSSI) is being cancelled for 2025 due to lack of youth sign up for the program. We would normally have at least 6 to 7 Troops with confirmed participation but this year we only have 1. As a result, we are canceling the event this year. I know a lot of folks were looking forward to having youth coming out and participate in the many activities that we sponsor but there just wasn't the numbers there to do it this year. Hopefully we will be able to have this event in 2026 and have more youth coming out.

Law Enforcement Range Use - Just a quick note that we have had several requests by local and state law enforcement groups to use our ranges for doing various qualification efforts. Please

Hunting Is Prohibited - We have recently been alerted to evidence of individuals killing animals on our property. There are several issues with this. If you are caught shooting wild game on our property, it will be immediate revocation of your membership as well as being turned over to the appropriate law enforcement groups for potential prosecution.
